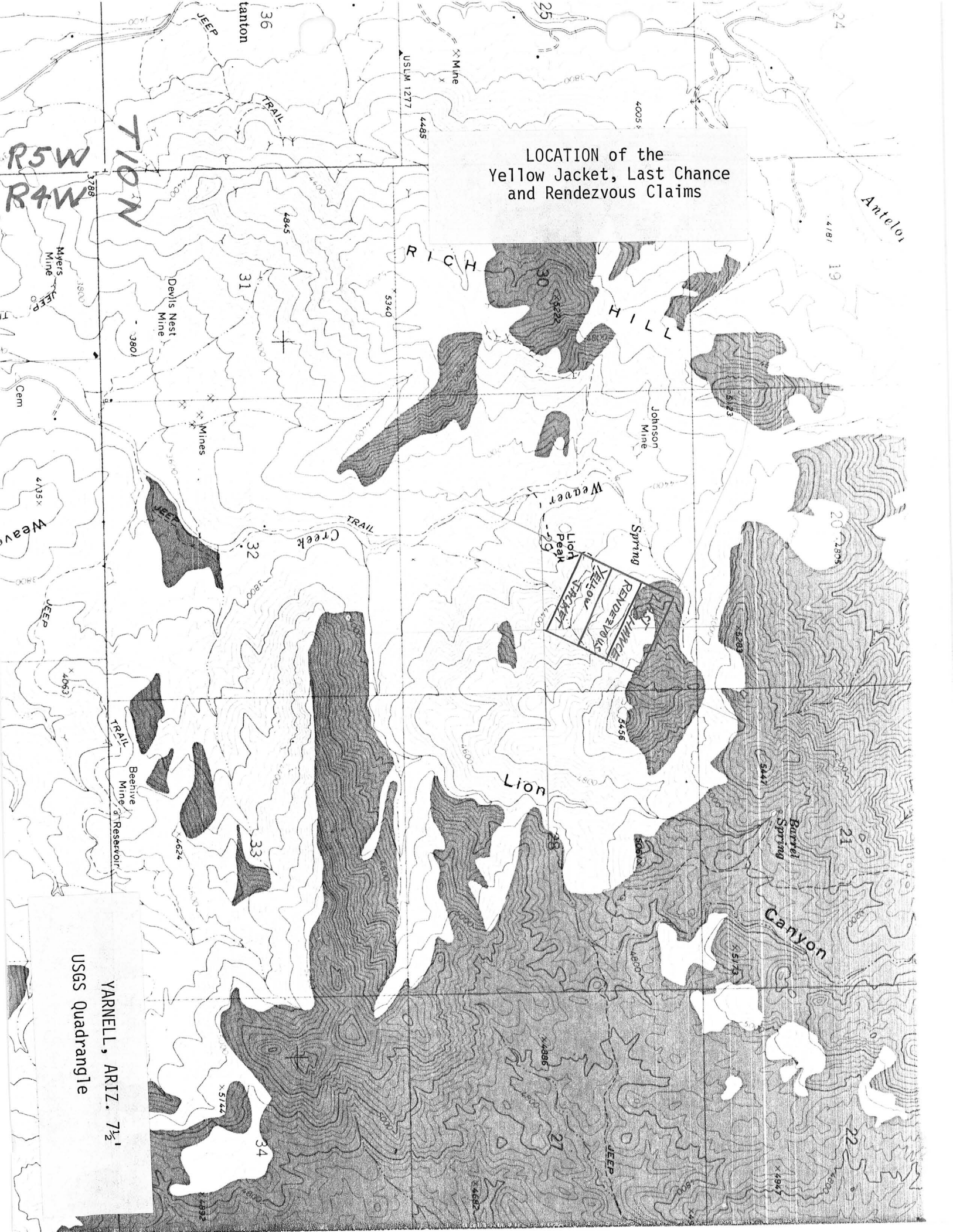

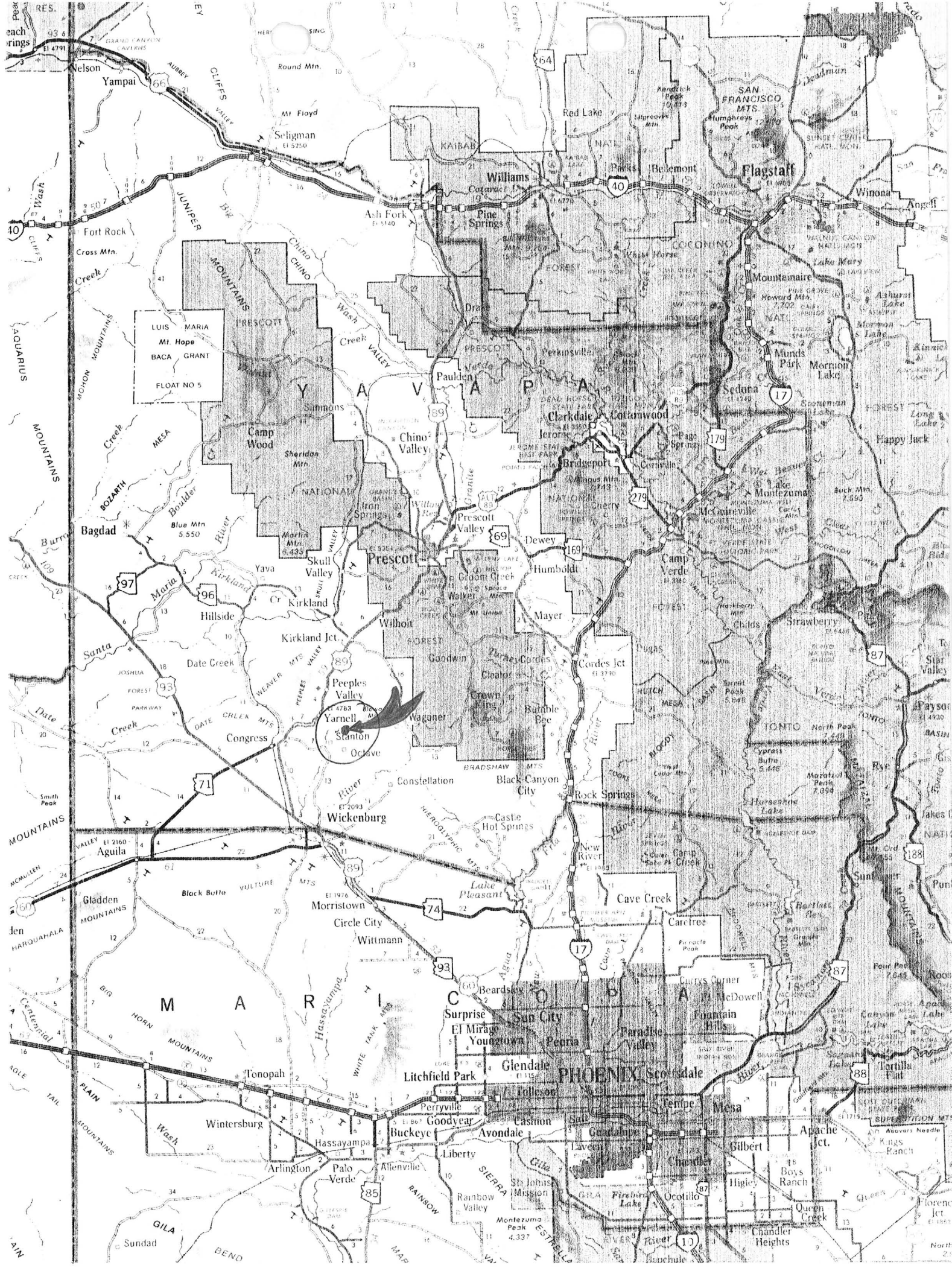

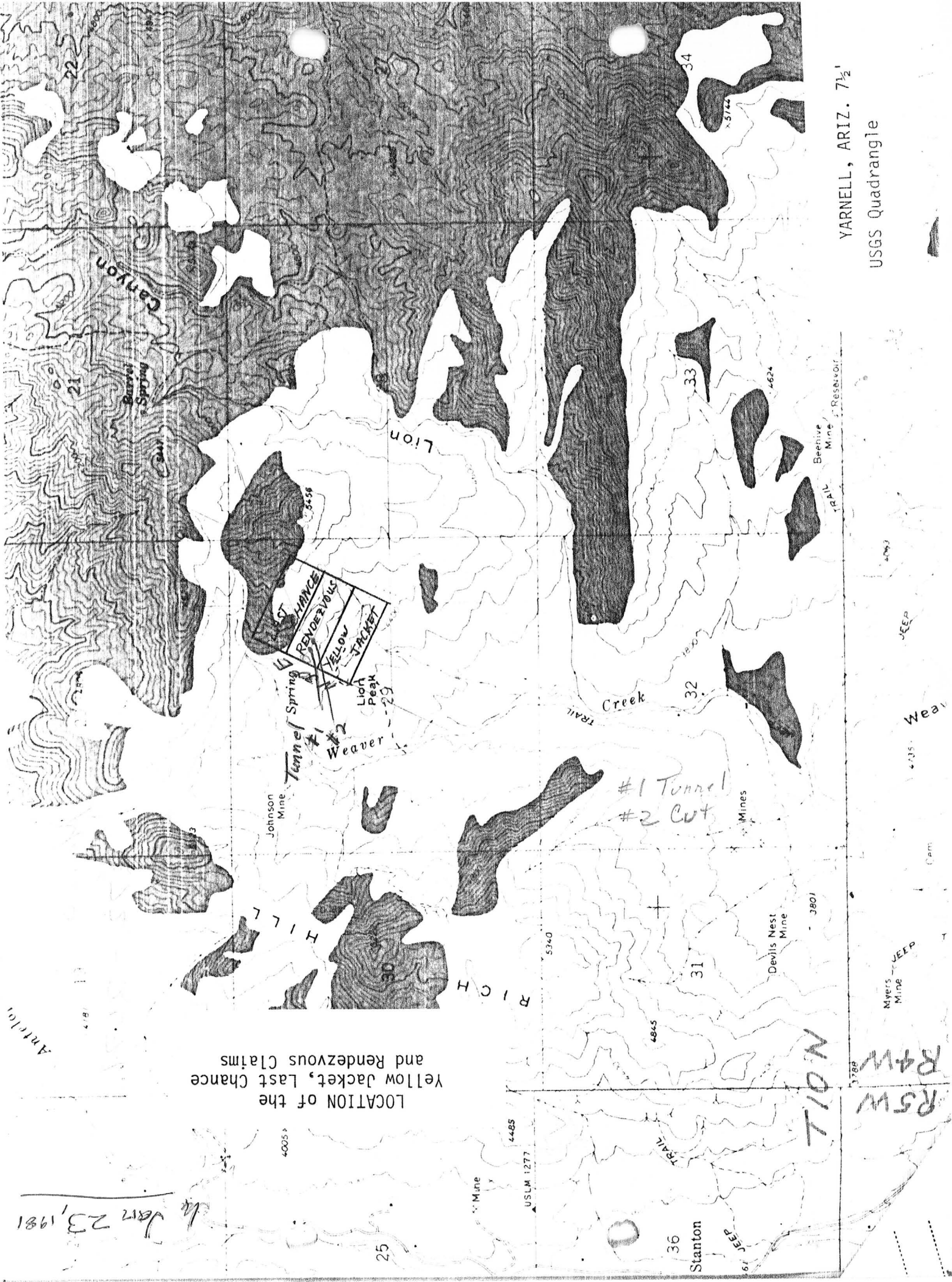


YARNELL, ARIZ. 7 1/2'

Subject: Mine Visit

The author accompanied the owner on a reconnaissance tour of the Rendezvous, the Yellow Jacket, and the Last Chance claims. These three claims are a contiguous group located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 29, T10N, R4W, in Yavapai County.

The principal rock type appears to be a granite intruded by numerous narrow widely spaced quartz veins striking north-westerly and dipping northerly. Visible gold appears in some of the veins and in the wall rock adjacent to the veins. One outcrop carried considerable galena at the surface but became barren at a depth of 4 to 5 feet.

At some time in the past, an adit was driven on what is now the Rendezvous claim, bearing N 85° E for approximately 90 feet and then N 65° E to a total length of 165 feet. It was apparently following the strike of a 14 inch wide fault zone. A cut near a saddle on the Last Chance claim made by the present owner, revealed a fault zone approximately 2 feet wide striking N 35° E and dipping 57° to the northwest.

The assays indicate surprisingly low grade rock (see sample chart) even in veins where visible gold was noted. This leads to the conclusion that the mineralization must be extremely spotty and localized.

The narrowness and wide spacing of the quartz stringers make this property very difficult to develop unless some very high grade stringers can be located or if they converge at depth. Careful mapping of the exposed stringers to ascertain their strike and dip will be required to estimate the point of their convergence. If indicated, a drilling program could then verify the structure and provide samples of the mineralization.
