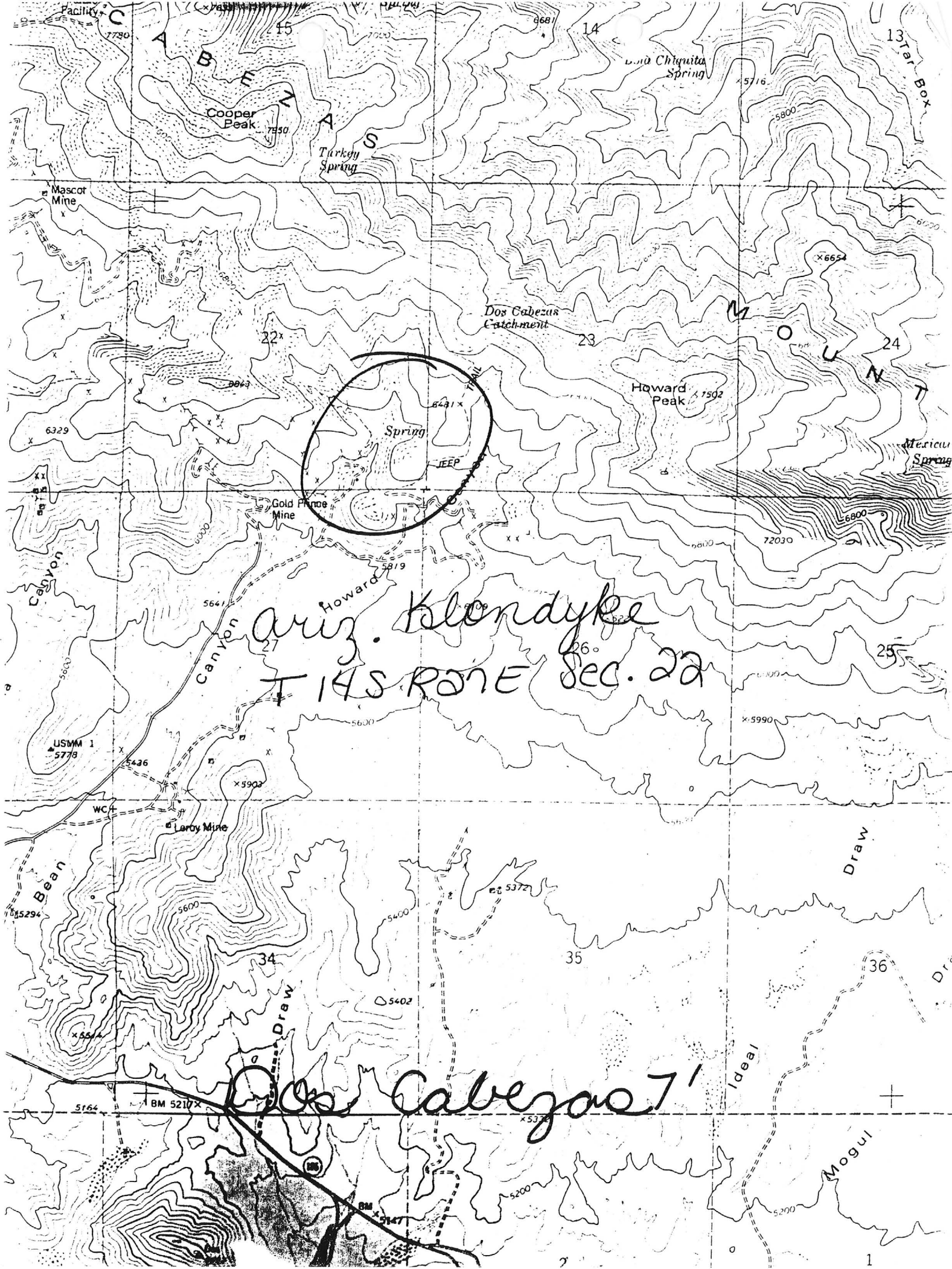

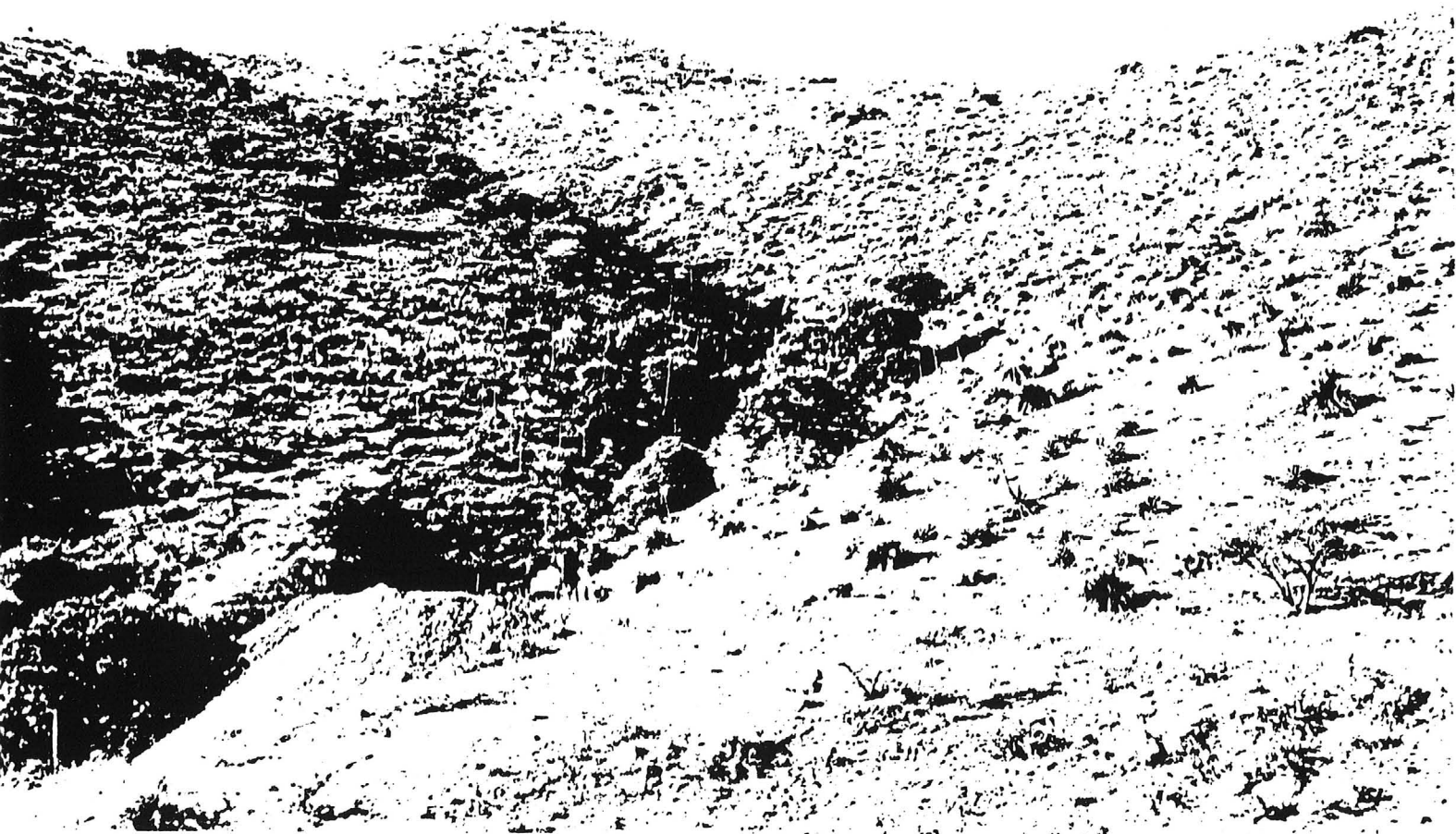

MG WR 8/16/85: Visited the Arizona Klondyke mine (Cochise Co). House in SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec 22, is occupied by Chris & Laura Barry, Dos Cabezas Route, Box 3445, Willcox, Az. 85643. The Hyde tunnel is about 0.1 mile northwest of the house. Another adit is about 0.15 mile north of the Hyde tunnel. Phelps Dodge has repaired the portal (in quartzite?) of the Hyde tunnel and has improved the road. Small dumps containing abundant phyllite (or shale) and some quartz occur at each adit. The Arizona Klondyke appears to occur in a geologic environment similar to the nearby Gold Prince mine.
